The stories coming out of the trial of abortion provider Kermit Gosnell are beyond simple characterization. For the first time, even those in favor of abortion are shocked. Gosnell was found guilty of 3 counts of first degree murder, for snipping the spines of babies born alive after his botched abortions. The methods he used for murder are so brutal that he must, in all objectivity, be placed along side some of the worst serial killers in history.

At *New Hope Pregnancy Care* as we followed the Gosnell trial and follow related stories, all of us have gone through a variety of emotions; from mourning, to anger, to, at some points, despair. How could this happen? What can we do? And yet, in the midst of all of this we are reminded: *God placed New Hope Pregnancy Care here to be a light of hope so that every person in our community will be empowered to choose life.*

You see, no one goes to an abortion center because they see it as a great idea. Instead, they see abortion as the only way out of a terrible situation. We are here to show those who are unsure, uncertain, fearful . . . That though the situation they find themselves in *appears* hopeless, there is hope. We are here to listen, and we are here to say with all of the love we have, "You don't *have* to go there; we are here to walk with you through this time. And as we walk hand-in-hand, we will not let go."

The answer is this ministry and others like ours who are offering true hope to those who are hurting, to those who believe abortion is their only option. I believe this: If we become the first choice for those facing unplanned pregnancies, fewer and fewer will consider going to abortion centers like Kermit Gosnell's. What about those abortion

centers that do remain open? Without customers wanting abortions, they will close. Our mission then, is to continually build *New Hope Pregnancy Care* so that we will be that first choice. And when the scared and confused come in our door, we must serve them with excellence, with hope and with love.

To fulfill this mission, we look forward to expanding our services. Over the last few months we have updated our website, added a Facebook page, and Twitter feed to help reach our target market. In the next year as God provides we want to offer free, confidential STI testing and free prenatal care for those without insurance/medicaid.

Honestly, we can't do this alone. We *need* you. If you have yet to step forward in support of *New Hope Pregnancy Care*, this is the time. We need your involvement. Most of the clients that we see at New Hope Pregnancy Care do not attend a church at all or at least not regularly. They usually ask us if we know of any "good" churches that they would "fit" into. In some instances they have had a bad experience previously and are scared to go back. We really want our clients to be in a good church where they can be disciplined and get support during this time. In the past we have not given any referrals because we do not want to send them someplace that would not welcome them and also we do not know what church would be the right place for them. We would like to make a church referral packet to give to our clients and then they can decide where they want to visit.
