Statement of Faith

1. We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative Word of God.
2. We believe that there is one God, eternally existent in three persons; Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
3. We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory.
4. We believe that for the salvation of lost and sinful man, regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely essential, and that this salvation is received through faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and not as a result of good works.
5. We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life and to perform good works.
6. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; they that are saved unto the resurrection of life and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation.
7. We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ.

Statement of Principle

1. Compassion Care Center is an outreach ministry of Jesus Christ through His church. Therefore, Compassion Care Center, embodied in its volunteers, is committed to presenting the gospel of our Lord to women experiencing stressful pregnancies---both in word and in deed. Commensurate with this purpose, those who labor as board members, directors, and volunteers are expected to know Christ as their Savior and Lord.
2. Compassion Care Center is committed to providing its clients with accurate and complete information about prenatal development, abortion, and sexually transmitted diseases.
3. Compassion Care Center is committed to integrity in dealing with clients, earning their trust and providing promised information and services. Compassion Care Center denounces any form of deception in its corporate advertising or individual conversations with its client.
4. Compassion Care Center is committed to assisting women to carry to term by providing emotional support and practical assistance. Through the provision of God's people and the community at large, women may face the future with hope, and plan constructively for themselves and their babies.
5. Compassion Care Center does not discriminate in providing services because of race, creed, color, national origin, age, or marital status of its clients.
6. Compassion Care Center does not recommend, provide, or refer for abortion or abortifacients.
7. Compassion Care Center offers assistance free of charge at all times.
8. Compassion Care Center is committed to creating awareness within the local community of the needs of pregnant women, and of the fact that abortion only compounds human need rather than resolving it.
9. Compassion Care Center does not recommend, provide, or refer single women for contraceptive. Married women seeking contraceptive information should seek counsel, along with their husband, from their pastor and physician.
10. Compassion Care Center recognizes the validity of adoption as one alternative to abortion, but is not biased toward adopting when compared to the other life-saving alternatives. This center is independent of adoption agencies, relating to them in the same manner as to other helpful referral sources. Compassion Care Center receives no payment of any kind from these agencies, does not enter into contractual relationships with the, and does not share combined office space. Adoption agencies are not established under the auspices of this center. Compassion Care Center neither initiates nor facilitates independent adoptions, though they may refer for independent adoptions in states where it is legal.
11. Compassion Care Center seeks to aid women who are experiencing emotional problems following an abortion by offering compassionate counseling, which enables them to work through their loss and Post Abortion Syndrome.
12. Compassion Care Center seeks to provide single clients with information on sexual risk avoidance and healthy relationships.

Commitment to Care

1. Clients are served without regard to age, race, income, nationality, religious affiliation, disability or other arbitrary circumstances.
2. Clients are treated with kindness, compassion and in a caring manner.
3. Clients always receive honest and open answers.
4. Client pregnancy tests are distributed and administered in accordance with all applicable laws.
5. Client information is held in strict and absolute confidence. Client information is only disclosed as required by law and when necessary to protect the client or others against imminent harm.
6. Clients receive accurate information about pregnancy, fetal development, lifestyle issues, and related concerns.
7. We do not offer, recommend or refer for abortions or abortifacients, but we are committed to offering accurate information about abortion procedures and risks.
8. All of our advertising and communications are truthful and honest and accurately describe the services we offer.
9. All of our staff and volunteers receive proper training to uphold these standards.
