"NEW"

The Old Testament prophet Elisha is described as "the man of God" in the book of II Kings; he had the powerful ability to see God's hand when others could not.

In the story of the Aramean plot to capture Elisha, we read Elisha knew exactly what the king of Aram was planning, without being anywhere near him (II Kings 6:12). And, when the king sent an army after Elisha, this man of God could see God's army protecting him (II Kings 6:16-17).

A powerful moment in this story is when Elisha prays that his servant might see too. When the servant, who could only see the army arrayed against them, has his eyes opened by God, "he saw; and behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha."

From fear, the servant gained strength, knowing God's army was "more than those who are with them."

At Compassion Care Center, part of our calling is to see what our clients and patients cannot. We may not gain a picture as clear as Elisha could, but when a client comes in our door almost paralyzed by fear, part of our mission is to help her see God is still present and available. He can be called

upon in the most trying times of our lives.

And when God shows up, there are always more with us than against us. As we reach out to those who are hurting and afraid, we are asking God to open her eyes to what *can* be. We want her to envision that while the present circumstances may seem daunting, God has the supernatural ability to re-write her story.

An unexpected pregnancy is not the end of her book of hope, but the beginning of a new chapter involving a new life. Adoption could be part of her new story. Parenting and marriage could be a part of her new story. The emphasis however, is always on "new."

"New" takes place when we see from God's perspective.

Like Elisha's servant, we find seeing with new eyes changes everything. As we pull together as volunteers, board members, financial partners, prayer warriors, staff members and various other components of our team, let's commit to asking for God's vision for those we see. As we do, let's pray also that the eyes of our clients will be opened to the wonder of what God can do.
